

AutoProc Academic Software License

This is an academic right-to-use license for the program package AutoProc (the Software) copyright, 2002 by M. Bayro, M.C. Baran, G.T. Montelione, and Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey, for referencing, processing, and analysis of NMR data. The program package includes source and executable computer code for the AutoProc software and documentation. By accepting and using a copy of this software, you and your institution agree to license this Software from Rutgers according to the following terms:

- 1) You are granted non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Software at a single site for internal non-commercial research purposes only (License). Use includes storing, loading, installing, executing, using, or displaying the software. This license will terminate automatically if you transfer, or disclose, any part of the software to anyone else.
